

Nacex collaborates in fighting against two diseases: multiple sclerosis and AIDS

Barcelona, 23 July 2009. - Nacex, Grupo Logista's parcel and express courier firm, joins other entities in campaigns organized by foundations fighting against two diseases: AIDS and multiple sclerosis, which currently don't have definitive remedies and so eradicate them.

In particular, the company collaborates one more year with the Fundación Esclerosis Múltiple (Multiple Sclerosis Foundation) in the campaign MÓJATE (COMMIT) held last July 12th in swimming pools and beaches throughout the country, and consisting in an act of civil participation and fundraising, aimed at improving the quality of care given to those affected and to support research against Multiple Sclerosis, which in our country is estimated to affect 40,000 people. This year some 95,000 people took part in the campaign and swam 63,500,000 meters.

Nacex also collaborates with the Fundación Lucha contra el SIDA (Fight against AIDS Foundation) for the second consecutive year to raise funds for research projects by the Foundation. This year, the group Pastora collaborated through a summer concert held last July 3rd in Barcelona. Next December 1st, commemorating the world day against the disease, a new concert will be held for the same purpose with an artist involved in the cause, Miguel Bosé, as he did the previous year.
